ANNUAL REPORT 2024

Friends,

Gulf Coast Kid's House (GCKH) turned 20 this year! It was a great opportunity to celebrate how far we've come and to look at what we want to accomplish in the future. We had so much fun celebrating with our supporters at our Roaring 20s-themed Anniversary Party and loved welcoming the community into our House for cake and champagne for our Birthday Party.

This year, we were grateful to expand our mental health services in terms of therapeutic intervention and adding another therapy position. We continued to offer Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) and our Adult Recovery Group for adults who were impacted by child abuse. On the other end of the spectrum, our team had the opportunity to reassess and improve our forensic interview and observation process. Our investigative partners improved their response and are again present at every forensic interview. This live observation is critical to the child advocacy model and leads to better outcomes for our cases. Now that partner staffing has stabilized, we are overjoyed that a process is in place to ensure 100% compliance with these observations.

One challenge we face in continually growing to meet the evolving needs of our community is that we quite literally have run out of room to do the work. We have outgrown our facility again and have been forced to get creative with space as we've expanded our team and services. Our Board of Directors has begun strategizing another expansion campaign. In our early phases, we are carefully considering what the additional space will look like and what services will be best provided there. We are beyond grateful to Caldwell & Associates for donating the design of an additional space, which will eventually be right across Anderson Street to our South. One thing we do know about this future space is that it will be home to our Therapy Garden, which the Board graciously dedicated to my late mom, Betsy Robins.

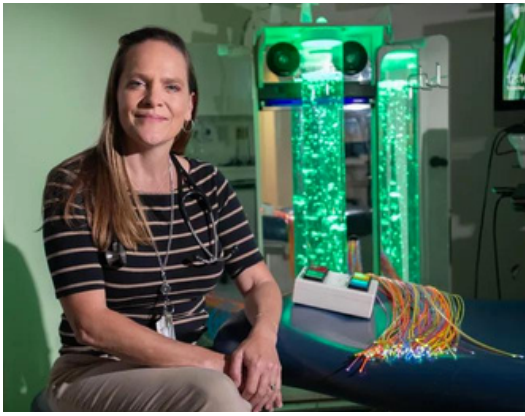
Mental Health has been a hot topic in our country and community for the last four years. While we have seen internet crimes against children skyrocket during the last four years, we have also seen an increase in children with problematic sexual behavior. Working hand in hand with the Department of Children and Families, it was discovered and validated that there are very few resources for these children to get treatment. GCKH has applied for our therapists and administration to receive specialized training so we can work with this important and unique population.

In closing, I'm sure you've noticed that we all are busier than ever, and we are all struggling with rising costs of basic needs. It seems that there aren't enough hours in the day or dollars in the bank for anyone. I'm writing this letter fresh off the tails of the 2024 Olympics – where there was an amazing show of strength, grit, resilience, and camaraderie by dedicated athletes. Like those athletes, we will continue to train, improve, perfect, and dig deep when we are tired because the work doesn't stop, and the children need our help. Thank you for being part of our small army of difference-makers. I hope that we have made you proud. We are excited to see what the future holds.

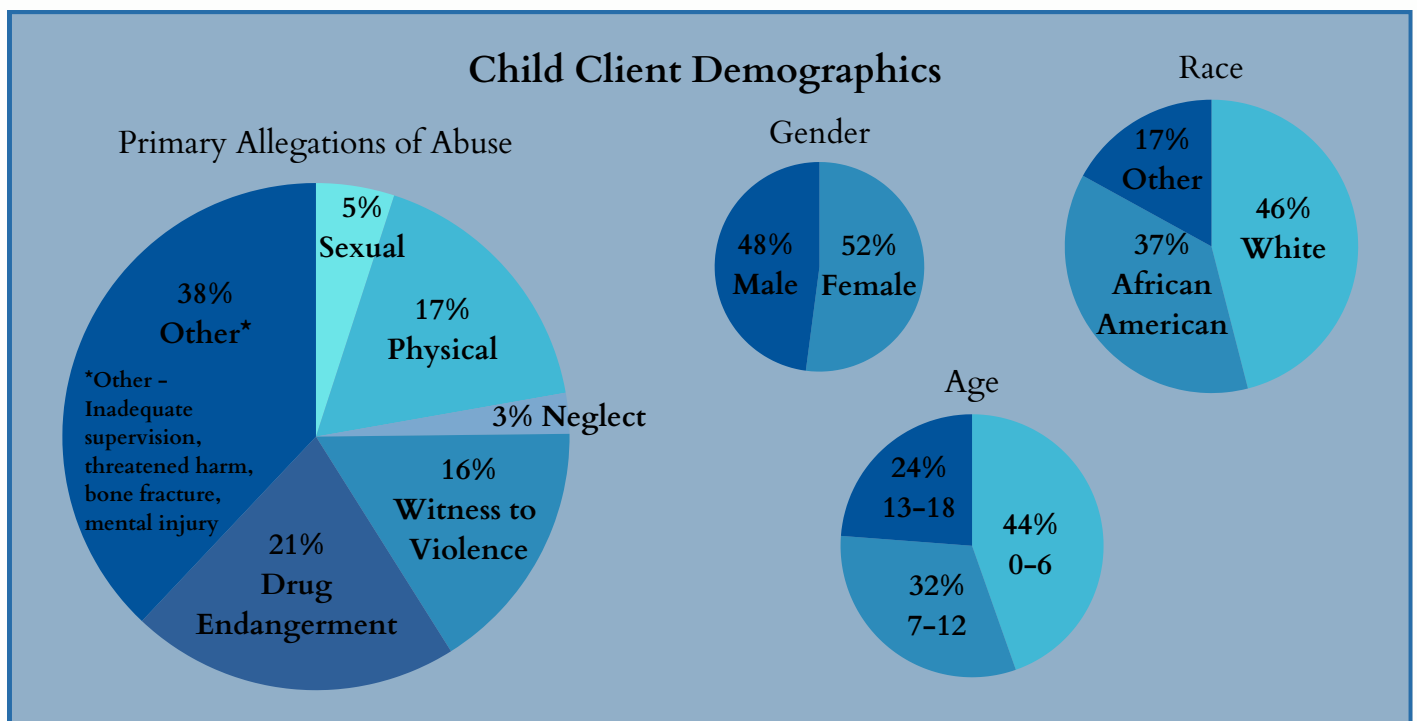

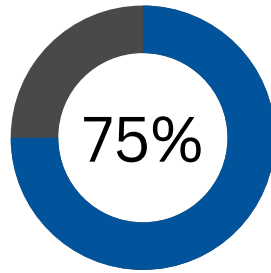
